**Author entries** are sorted as follows:

The author's own essays, reviews etc. are listed in date order first.

Cross-references to books by the author (which appear in Reviews) are listed in italic after essays, by book title in alphabetical order, with the note: *See Reviews*....

Reviews are split into three categories: Merton's Books, Books about Merton, and Other Books. Each category is sorted alphabetically by the book title. The book title is stated most fully in the Reviews list, and in a shorter form as a cross-reference.
